DIVERTED - Animals who we were able to help keep out of the shelter by providing help and offering resources to the owner. This program is also knows as our Pet Retention Program.

HUMANE EUTHANASIA - Our Chief Veterinarian authorizes all euthanasia decisions for medical reasons. Euthanasia for behavior is authorized by shelter managers, supervisors and directors. All euthanasia decisions are made on a case-by-case basis.

TNR ("Trap Neuter Return") and our "Working Whiskers" programs allow feral ("wild") cats to continue living their lives, outdoors. These cats vaccinated, fixed. are ear-tipped. microchipped and released.
